An Accredited School of International Repute

Welcome to Traill International School. Established in 1966 by the late Mr Anthony Traill, the school is one of the oldest International Schools in Thailand. His vision of a British International School where students are valued individually, are challenged academically, and given opportunities in wide range of sporting and cultural activities underpins the philosophy of the school today. The school is still family owned, though administered and run by professional educators, of wide international experience.

Traill School is internationally recognized and fully accredited with the Council for British Teachers (CfBT) and Worldwide Educational Services (WES). We are also licensed and registered in Thailand with the Thai Ministry of Education and registered as a British school with the Department for Education and Skills in England. In addition, Traill was the first school in Thailand authorized as an examination center by the Cambridge International Examinations Board and is a member of The European Council of International Schools. We can state with confidence that Traill has gained international credentials superior to most other schools in Thailand.

Entry Requirements

Students may apply to enter the school at any time during the school year, and at any class level. The school takes students from 2 ½ years of age. Entry is subject to the availability of places. Prospective students are interviewed, and entrance tests measure, especially, the level of acquisition of English language. Test and interview times are arranged through the school office.

Curriculum

The school follows the UK National Curriculum. Students in the Nursery (Pre Kindergarten), Playgroup (KG1) and Reception (KG2) follow the Early Years foundation stage curriculum. Children in Year 1 - 6 follow the British National Curriculum. Primary students sit the British Key Stage 1 SATs Test (Standard Attainment Test) in Year 2 and the Key Stage 2 SATs Test in Year 6. The tests are the same as those administered to Year 2 and Year 6 children in all British Curriculum Schools.

At Year 7 students enter the secondary school, and study a range of subjects for three years (Years 7, 8 and 9) taught by specialist teachers. Key Stage 3 SATs are studied until the end of Year 9. Students in Years 10 and 11 work towards their International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) examinations, where they have a choice of subject sitting between 8 and 10 IGCSE subjects at the end of Year 11. In Years 12 and 13 students prepare for British A-level examinations, which, on successful completion, give them access to universities worldwide.

Extra-curricular Activities

The school provides students with a wide range of opportunities to develop skills and interests in the fields of creativity, action and service whether it is in sport, performance or community service.

Teaching and Support Staff

The teaching staff are the driving force behind the high standard international education we offer at Traill. Because our curriculum is based on the UK model, the majority of staff are British, but we also employ other suitably qualified teachers as befits our international status. . All staff are graduates, are fully qualified as teachers in their country of origin, and have been granted teaching licences to teach in Thailand.

English as a Second Language

The language of instruction is English. For students who enter the school with little or no English, the school has a special immersion ESL unit, to help them prepare for mainstream classes. ESL support continues after students enter mainstream.
